

MINUTES OF THE REPUBLICAN COUNTY COMMITTEE OF BRONX COUNTY
HELD ON September 22, 2025 AT 6:30PM AT 2680 Schurz Ave, Bronx, NY 10465

MICHAEL A. RENDINO called the 2025 organizational meeting of the Bronx Republican County Committee notices by Chairman MICHAEL A. RENDINO, pursuant to section 2-112 of the election law to order and read the Notice of meeting dated September 22, 2025 at 6:30 PM, and asked the Sergeant at Arms if there is a quorum present.

ROCCO CIROTTI, the Sergeant at Arms, reported that there was a quorum of the Bronx Republican County Committee present.

MICHAEL A. RENDINO recognized FRED BROWN, who nominated STEVEN GUGLIEMI as Temporary Chairman. SHEEMEN CHAPEL seconded the nomination. Steve Demartis moved that the nominations be closed. All those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', any opposed. There being none STEVEN GUGLIEMI was elected Temporary Chairman and assumed THE CHAIR.

THE CHAIR then entertained motions for nomination of Temporary Secretary and for that purpose THE CHAIR recognized FRANK TOSI for the purpose of nominating SHEMEEN CHAPPELL as Temporary Secretary. KAJARA BOYD seconded the nomination. THE CHAIR moved that the nominations be closed. All those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', any opposed. There being none SHEMEEN CHAPPELL was elected Temporary Secretary.

THE CHAIR then entertained a motion for the waiving of the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and for that purpose THE CHAIR recognized FRANK TOSI who made the motion of waving the reading of the minutes. RICHARD RIBUSTELLO seconded the motion. All those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and the motion to waive the reading of the previous minutes was carried.

THE CHAIR then entertained a motion for the nomination of Chairman/President of the Bronx Republican County Committee and for that purpose recognized FRED BROWN, who nominated MICHAEL A. RENDINO as Chairman/President of the Bronx Republican County Committee. JOSE COLON seconded the nomination. Are there any other nominations? There being none RAPHAEL SAVINO moved that the nominations be closed. All those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and MICHAEL A. RENDINO was unanimously elected Chairman/President of the Bronx Republican County Committee. At which time MICHAEL A. RENDINO assumed THE CHAIR.

THE CHAIR called for further nominations, there being none, all those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and FRED BROWN was elected Vice Chairman of the Bronx Republican County Committee.

THE CHAIR then entertained a motion for the nomination of First Vice President of the Bronx Republican County Committee and for that purpose recognized Frank Tosi who nominated Steven Guglielmi as First Vice President of the Bronx Republican County Committee. STEVE DEMARTIS seconded the nomination. THE CHAIR called for further nominations, there being none, all those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and STEVEN GUGLIELMI was elected First Vice President of the Bronx Republican County Committee.

THE CHAIR then entertained a motion for the nomination of Secretary of the Bronx Republican County Committee and for that purpose recognized ROCCO CIROTTI who nominated Kathleen Simpson as Secretary of the Bronx Republican County Committee. SHEMEEN CHAPPELL seconded the nomination. THE CHAIR called for further nominations, there being none, all those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and Kathleen Simpson was elected Secretary of the Bronx Republican County Committee.

ROSALINE NIEVES seconded the nomination. THE CHAIR called for further nominations, there being none, all those in favor signify by saying 'Aye', opposed no, the 'ayes' have it and KAJARA BOYD was elected Recording Secretary of the Bronx Republican County Committee.
